She appointed Tukojirao Holkar as the Chief of Army. Rani Ahilyadevi was a great pioneer and builder of Hindu temples. She built hundreds of temples and Dharmshalas throughout India. Celebrated for her exemplary leadership, progressive governance, and deep commitment to cultural and social development. She redefined the role of women in leadership and left an indelible mark on Indian history.
