Special Youth Camp Report 2018-19

Mauje Mogra Taluka Majalgaon District Beed

(Camp Duration Date 5 January to 11 January 2019)

Sri Siddheshwar College Majalgaon National Service Scheme Department and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad completed a special youth camp at the adopted village Mauje Mogra. The Department of National Service Scheme was established by the Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs, Government of India from the birth centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi.

In the affiliated colleges of the university, this scheme is working in the form of a unit in which the principal of the college works as a volunteer etc. in the active group complete sanitation campaign, water conservation, water management, disaster management, de-addiction, environmental awareness and tree plantation, eradication of superstition, youth development, poverty-free village enlightenment and rural reconstruction, women empowerment, clean & prosperous village, prosperous country, etc.

Sri Siddheshwar College Majalgaon District Beed, National Service Scheme Department, and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad organized a special youth camp at Dattak village Mauje Mogra with the concept of water conservation and water management from January 5 to January 11, 2019. For this camp, Village Sarpanch Aruna Baban Pawar, Gramsevak Honorable Bajrang Rathod, Honorable Baban Pawar, Honorable Babasaheb Shinde, College Principal Dr. Bhalchandra Karad, Program Officer Prof. Dr. Gajanan Honna, Prof. Yuvraj Mule, Prof. Dr. Chhaya Kodharkar, Volunteers, Villagers organized a development oriented program.

The camp was inaugurated by Hon. Ashok Pannalalji Jain (President Vaidyanath Urban Bank, Parli), Hon'ble Umeshji Mogrekar (Taluka President Journalist Sangh Majalgaon) was the main presence while Hon'ble Amarnath Ji Khurpe (karyawah Local Coordinating Committee) was present as a guide Hon'ble Prakashji Dugad (President Local Coordinating Committee Majalgaon), Sarpanch, Gramsevak Honorable Bajrang Rathod, Honorable Baban Pawar, Honorable Babasaheb Shinde, Principal Dr. Bhalchandra Karad, Student Representative Akshay Ladda, Student Representative Supriya Chandmare etc. were present on the stage. Chandmare, Kumari Kaveri Pohekar, Kumari Divya Ranjvan, Kumari Chhaya Chavan presented in the Inauguration. It was coordinated by Prasad Gaikwad and vote of thanks was given by Prof. Dr. Gajanan Honna. Senior citizen Padmakar Joshi was present as the chairman of the session.

Keeping in mind the daily routine of the campers, the daily activities started with exercise, yoga and prayer.

On January 6, 2019, morning round was taken out from the village and then the Narsingh Ghat of the Godavari River at Mauje Mogra was cleaned. In the

meantime, the citizens of the area were urged to keep the ghat clean and beautiful. The villagers actively participated in cleaning the ghat. In the afternoon session, Prof. Gangadhar Ushamwar and Prof. Tulshiram Munde gave lectures on the responsibility and duty of volunteers and Prof. Dr. Sitaram Ingole presided over the evening session. Prof. Dr. Vikas Borgaonkar and Vinayak Deshmukh guided the program on the topic of development. Prof. Dr. Shivshankar Mitkari concluded the program in the chair. The session was attended by a large number of villagers.

On January 7, 2019, a morning round was conducted and public awareness was created by giving an announcement about cleanliness. School students and villagers were present in large numbers in this morning round. The campers immediately solved the problems that were possible. In the afternoon session, Prof. Dr. Sachin Dabhade and Prof. Raghavendra Shirshikar guided the topic of Computer Yesterday, Today and Tomorrow. Prof. Dr. Sanjay Kale was present in the chair and in the night session, Prof. Dr. Mahesh Deshmukh and Prof. Dr. Kedarnath Malu were present. Prof. Ashok Kale presided over the presentation on the topic of 'Search for Quality in Higher Education', followed by a cultural program.

On January 8, 2019, the morning round was conducted. Villagers and students participated in large numbers. An appeal was made to keep Mogra village clean, beautiful and healthy. After that, the volunteers cleaned the village in groups and worked to make a mud embankment on the village water stream. After lunch at 17:00 Prof. Dr. Tatyia Puri and Prof. Dr. Premadas Rathod gave guidance on the topic of Village Development through public participation. Prof. Balaji Bodke was presiding on this occasion. After answering the questions asked by the students, the principal of the college, Dr. Bhalchandra Karad held a meeting of the students and reviewed the camp. At this time, the program officer and the campers were present

in the night session. Dr. Kamalkishore Ladda and Prof. Sanjay Pawar guided on the topic of Skilled India. Prof. Dr. Arun Pentawar was the chairperson of the session. Villagers participated in this program.

On 9th January 2019, complete cleanliness in the village along with Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat members and dignitaries of the village. After the campaign was carried out, labor was donated by making a mud dam on a stream of water in the village. In the afternoon session, Prof. Jijaram Bagal gave guidance on the topic of cleanliness and service. Dr. Tatyia Sondge, vice president was present at this time. On this occasion, Prof. Umesh Sadegaonkar was present as the chairman who gave guidance on the topic of Need of Time.

On January 10, 2019, morning round was conducted and the work of making a mud embankment on a stream of water was completed by donating labor it was filmed and displayed by the channel Maharashtra News. In the afternoon session Mr. Laxmikant Joshi gave guidance on Zero Budget Farming. Mr. Ashok Hoke presided over the program while in the night session ten famous poets of the taluka participated in the Bahardar Kavi Sammelan. Poems were presented on this topic. On this occasion, the campers presented their poems. Prof. Dr. Ramesh Gatkal and Dr. Dnyaneshwar Gawte coordinated the poetry meeting.
