Special Youth Camp Report 2019-20

Mauje Nakalgaon Taluka Majalgaon District Beed
(Camp Duration Date 17th December to 23rd December 2019.)

Sri Siddheshwar College Majalgaon National Service Scheme Department and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad completed a special youth camp at Dattak village Mauje Nakalgaon. National Service Scheme Department was established by the Ministry of Sports and Youth Affairs, Government of India from the birth centenary year of Mahatma Gandhi.

In the affiliated colleges of the university, the scheme is working as a unit in which the principal of the college, program officer, volunteers etc. work in a creative group.

In this unit, in regular programs, labor donation, tree plantation, blood donation camp, health camp, literacy week, education classes, etc., are implemented through special camps, social programs are implemented at the rural level, mainly the entire cleanliness campaign, one volunteer, one tree, skill development and self-employment, AIDS awareness, water conservation, water management, disaster management, de-addiction, environment awareness and tree plantation, Eradication of superstition, Personality development, Road safety campaign, Tobacco free campaign, Violence free village awareness, and rural

reconstruction, Women empowerment, Clear village prosperous village, Prosperous country etc.

Sri Siddheshwar College Majalgaon District Beed National Service Scheme Department and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad Special Youth Camp was held at Dattak village Mauje Mogra with the concept of cleanliness from 17th December to 23rd December 2019. Sarpanch of the village Hon. Vitthalrao Gawli, Gramsevak Hon'ble Suresh Waghmare, Talathi Hon'ble Amit Milmille, Hon'ble Babasaheb Shinde, Principal Dr. Bhalchandra Karad, Program Officer Prof. Dr. Gajanan Honna, Prof. Yuvraj Mule, Prof. Dr. Chhaya Kodarkar, Volunteers, Villagers. A development-oriented program was organized.

The camp was inaugurated by Hon'ble Mr. Dr. Surendraji Alurkar (President BSP Sanstha Ambajogai) and Hon'ble Prakashji Dugad (President Local Coordinating Committee Majalgaon), Hon'ble Advocate Vishwasji Joshi (President Primary Division Majalgaon), Hon'ble Shri Sumantraoji Kulkarni (Secretary College Development Committee Majalgaon), Hon'ble Amarnathji Si Khurpe (Karyawah Local Coordinating Committee) was present as the chief guide, Hon'ble Abhayji Konkan (President College Development Committee Majalgaon) presided over as well as Sarpanch Hon'ble Vitthalrao Gawli, Gramsevak Hon'ble Suresh Waghmare, Talathi Hon'ble Amit Milmille, Hon'ble Babasaheb Shinde, Principal Dr. Bhalchandra Karad, Program Officer Dr. Gajanan Honna, Prof. Prof. Dr. Chhaya Kodarkar, volunteers, Villagers, Student Representative Prasad Gaikwad, Student Representative Divya Ranjwan were present on the stage. Principal Dr. Bhalchandra Karad introduced the opening session and the role of the camp. The session was moderated by Prasad Gaikwad and the vote of thanks was given by Rakhi Sonwane. Solanke guided the topic of benefits of GST. Dr. Sanjay Kale, head of the computer department of Swatantra Veer Savarkar College, chaired the session.

Keeping in mind the daily routine of the campers, the daily activities started with exercise, yoga and prayer. On 18th December 2019, a morning round was taken out from the village and then the Hanuman temple at Mauje Nakalgaon was cleaned. During this, the villagers were asked to keep the temple clean and beautiful. The villagers were active in cleaning the temple. In the afternoon session Prof. Suresh Bansode and college student Mr. Babasaheb Age lectured on water management and conservation and it was presided over by Prof. Dr. Sunil Patil. The program was concluded by Agricultural Assistant Gaurav Bapmare, the session was attended by a large number of villagers and volunteers.

On December 19, 2019, a Morning Round was conducted and public awareness was created by giving an announcement about cleanliness. In this Morning Round, a large number of school students and villagers were present. In the afternoon session Prof. Dr. Kamal Kishore Ladda and Prof. Ramesh Gatkalk guided on health and diet while President Prof. Dr. Mahesh Deshmukh was present. Prof. Dr. Vikas Borgaonkar was present as the chairperson after giving guidance on this topic, followed by a cultural program.

On 20th December 2019 morning round was held, villagers and students participated in large numbers, appeals were made to keep Nakalgaon clean, beautiful and healthy. After that, the volunteers cleaned the village in groups and filled the poth-holes on the village roads. After lunch, Prof. Dr. Gorakh Fasle and Prof. Abhigya Bhole gave guidance on the topic of AIDS awareness. Prof. Dr. Prem Ananda Gadsingh was presiding. During this time, the questions raised by the students were answered. After that, the principal of the college, Dr.

Bhalchandra Karad held a meeting of the students and reviewed the camp. The program officers and campers were present. In the night session, Prof. Balaji Bodke and Prof. Sanjay Pawar guided on the topic of addiction and tobacco freedom. The session was chaired by Prof. Dr. Shivshankar Mitkari and the villagers participated in the program in large numbers.

On December 21, 2019, a complete cleaning campaign was carried out in the village along with Sarpanch, Gram Panchayat members and prominent persons of the village, after which the main road connected between Alapur and Nakalgaon was leveled with mud and leveled with the collective participation of men and women of the village. And due to the flattening, the villagers are having a pleasant experience of coming and going by the road. All the work was done and labor was donated. In the afternoon session, Prof. Gopal Dhond and Prof. Shankar guided the road safety campaign up to this point. Dr. Tatyia Sondge was presiding. In the camp, Babu Savvashe gave a lecture on the subject of addiction, while the women of the village were given training on behalf of the Gas Agency Majalgaon about the care to be taken while handling gas.
