Keeping in mind the daily routine of the campers, the daily activities started with exercise, yoga and prayer. On 24 March 2022, a morning round was taken from the village and then the Hanuman temple at Mauje Nakalgaon was cleaned. In the afternoon session Prof. Dr. Prem Nanda Ghadsingh gave a lecture on Women Empowerment. The session was chaired by Prof. Dr. Kamal Kishore Ladda. The session was concluded by Mr. Raghavendra Shirshikar and a large number of villagers and volunteers attended the session.

On March 25, 2022, keeping in mind the daily routine of the campers, the daily activities started with exercise, yoga and prayer, after which a morning round was conducted and public awareness was created by giving announcements about cleanliness. Through this home visit, cleanliness issues were discussed and the problems were identified and the campers took immediate action to solve the problem. After that, the Satwai temple was cleaned and then the silt was removed from the Pazar lake near the village.
