### Important Instructions for Students

- 1) In line with the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020, the program-Course structure and the admission fee may change as per the instructions of the University Grants Commission, New Delhi and Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar.
- 2) Students are expected to read the prospectus carefully.
- 3) Student should remain present personally at the time of admission.
- 4) Attach original T.C. & its two photocopies along with two photocopies of Marks memo of qualifying examination.
- 5) At the time of the admission process, photocopy of Aadhaar card should be attached with the admission form
- 6) Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar is going to implement Choice Based Credit System as per the National Education Policy since the academic year 2024-25.
- 7) The students should notice the instructions given on the notice board, Whatsapp and E-mail by the Shri Siddheshwar Mahavidyalaya, Majalgaon.
- 8) To avoid further complication, students should properly verify the selected subjects from the office before completion of the admission process.
- 9) Students should timely follow the schedule of evaluation process viz. tests, Tutorials assignments, projects, practical examinations, etc.
- 10) For the overall development of students, their participation in co-curricular as well as extra curricular activities is highly expected. It may be the part of the syllabus.
- 11) 100 hours computer course is compulsory for first year B.A./ B.Sc. students. This exam will be conducted by the university at the end of the academic year. Students who have completed MS-CIT or taken Computer Science for B.Sc. will be exempted from the above course. Students who have completed the course of MS-CIT earlier should submit the certificate to the office during admission process.
- 12) Environment Studies is a compulsory subject for B.A./ B.Sc./ B.Com. Second Year students. It is essential to pass the examination conducted by the university at the end of the academic year. As a part of its evaluation process, it is mandatory to submit the project as per the guidelines. Students should attend the classes as per the schedule.
- 13) The study of the subject Constitution of India is compulsory. The examination will be held by the university at the end of the academic year B.A./ B.Sc./B.Com of First Year.
- 14) It is mandatory for students to have an average attendance of at least 75% in college. Apart from that, they will not be able to avail the benefits from the government schemes.
- 15) If the result of the examination is reserved by the university, as per the guidelines the students should complete compliance process necessary to declare the result within 08 days.



### Discipline of the College

- 1) Your behaviour must be in accordance with healthy academic working of the college. Any breach of discipline may invite cancellation of your admission from this college.
- 2) The Principal has all the powers with regard to annual gathering and other events. His/Her decision in these matters will be final.
- 3) You should go to the college office only when the office calls you or only when, It is absolutely necessary for you to visit the office. You should take care that you are not w a s t i n g time of the office staff.
- 4) You should always carry your Identity Card with you and show it whenever you are required to show it. Your identity card should be attested by the Principal.
- 5) No student will try to bring any direct or indirect political or any other influence on the college staff.
- 6) The use of mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the class room and in the college premises, (except academic purpose.)
- 7) Any activity like ragging will be punished under Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act. 1999.
- 8) Students behavior should be according to Teacher-Guardian Scheme undertaking. Otherwise admission will be cancelled

### Attendance, Tests and Submission of Tutorials / Practical

- 1) It is compulsory for students to attend regular classes. The University has fixed 75% attendance in classes to be eligible to take University Examinations. If your attendance falls short of this percentage, you will not be eligible to appear and attempt the University Exam.
- 2) Absence in one class will be treated as absence for the whole day.
- 3) The student must take part in all class tests and sessional works on the dates decided by the college /teacher. Absence in the tests leads to 'Failed' result in the end.
- 4) Students should submit homework of their subject promptly. (within time)
- 5) Students have to secure the passing marks under internal exams separately from the passing marks in the university exam..
- 6) To avoid the problems and complications, consult the subject teacher for details without any hesitation.

### Eligibility for Admission

#### Qualification for admission to First year B.A., B.Sc. & B. Com.

According to University Circular SAD/NP58/1991-92, Dr. Babasahab Ambedkar Marathwada University, the students seeking admission to first year course of B.A., B.Sc. & B.Com. should have one of the following qualifications:

- 1) He/She should have passed one of the following.:
  - i) H.S.C.
  - ii) Equivalent to above or below mentioned two courses.
    - a) He/She should have passed Diploma in Education (D.T.Ed.) examination with English as one of the subjects.
    - b) He/She should have passed three year Diploma course in Engineering of Maharashtra State Board of Technical Education
    - c) He/She should have passed Diploma course in Pharmacy (D. Pharm) approved by the Govt. of Maharashtra.
    - d) He/She should have passed XII class exam H.S.C. of the vocational education Board with English as one of the subjects.



### Rules of Admission

- 1) Students seeking admission to first year course obtaining 60% or more marks at their H.S.C. examination will get direct admission. Students who have obtained less than 60% marks at the H.S.C. examination will get admission according to number of seats available on merit basis.
- 2) Rules of reservation are applicable for admission. The quota of seats is as per the rules of Govt. of Maharashtra & Dr. B.A.M.U. Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar.
- 3) If the seats reserved for the backward communities are not filled within the given period, the same shall be converted to open category seats.
- 4) Students with bad record in respect of behaviour, studies performance, discipline and regularity shall not be admitted.
- 5) The students must pay all fees including practical fees and other charges at the time of admission.
- 6) The students must not change the subjects or group of subjects he/she has opted in the form after the admission is complete.
- 7) Admission given by the college is initially on the provisional basis & it will be considered final only after the approval of the University.
- 8) The Principal has the discretionary powers to make changes in the admission rules within the framework of the rules of the University and Govt. of Maharashtra.

Students should keep with them sufficient number of photo copies of their documents. The college will not give back the original documents and Transfer Certificate (T.C.) they are submitted with admission form.

- 5) Parent's Income Certificate below 2,00,000/-.
- 6) Ex-serviceman Certificate if required.
- 7) Physically challenged Certificate if required.
- 8) Domicile Certificate Xerox copy.
- 9) Adhar Card Xerox copy.
- 10) E-mail ID
- 11) Passport Photo (2 copies)
- 12) Original Migration Certificates  
(If you have studied in other University in the previous course.)



### Fees for Eligibility Certificate

The students seeking admission to the Ist year (semester I) course of this University have to get an eligibility certificate from the University. The Students should apply to the University through the College.

**The fees for this certificate is as follows :**

- Student who has passed HSC exam of the Chhatrapati Sambhajanagar Board- Rs. 50/-
- Student who has passed HSC exam from the Maharashtra HSC Board other than Chh.Sambhajanagar Board-Rs. 100/-
- Student who has passed HSC exam from a Board out side of Maharashtra Rs. 500/-
- Foreign Students-Rs. 12500/-

The Fees Structure is subject to change as per the instructions of the University The form for eligibility should be submitted along with an attested photo copy of your HSC examination and the migration certificate, (if necessary)

- 1) Hundred hours Computer course is compulsory for all the B.A. I, B.Sc.I, B.Com. I course. The students who have completed MS-CIT course or the students who are studying Computer Science as one of the subjects in their respective course are exempted from the course.
- 2) Six months Course in Environment Science is compulsory for B.A.,B.Sc. & B.Com. IInd year students.
- 3) There will be two lectures every week and related project work. Students have to study this course while they study for their degree course in their respective faculties. There will be annual university exam at the end of the year. The course fee prescribed by the university is Rs. 100/- The exam fee prescribed by the university is Rs. 50/-
- 4) In case, the student does not pass these courses his/her result in the faculty course will not be declared by the University.

- If the book is lost by student, He / She has to communicate it immediately to the Librarian and has to pay double the price of that book.
- All the books issued to the student should be returned before commencement of annual examination
- If the student has to retain books for the period of examination, he/she has to pay the amount twice to the price of that book as a deposit.
- All students must obtain Nodues certificate from the library before taking transfer certificate from the college.
- If library card is lost student has to inform to the librarian in writing and he/she will have pay Rs.100/- for the duplicate I card.
